1. As you read, record the character and character trait for each chapter on the rough copy
2. Use a 9X18 sheet of paper (I have this for you).
3. Fold the paper in half so that it is now 9x9.
4. On each side, measure 3 inches, fold those into the center to make the flaps of the book jacket.
5. On the cover include an illustration, the title, the author, and your name.
6. Color your cover.
7. On the left, inside flap, write a detailed description of the main character from the story (2 paragraphs).
8. On the right, inside flap, write a paragraph telling about the author of the book and include a picture. (in class work)
9. On the back write a 3-paragraph summary of the book.
10. Use correct spelling, grammar, capitalization, and punctuation.
11. Use the lined paper to help you write straight. You can get that from me.

Checklist

- I finished reading the whole book from cover to cover.
- I completed my rough copy and am ready to turn it in.
- I measured and folded my paper correctly.
- I included 2 paragraphs about the main character on my left flap.
- I included 1 paragraph about my author on the right flap.
