Day 1	Read ch. 1 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 2	Read ch. 2 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 3	Read ch. 3 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 4	Read ch. 4 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 5	Read ch. 5 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 6	Read ch. 6 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 7	Read ch. 7 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 8	Read ch. 8 or 10 pages and record some information.
Days 9-22	<b>Merry Christmas &amp; Happy New Year</b>
Day 23	Read ch. 9 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 24	Read ch. 10 or 10 pages and record some information.
Day 25	Read ch. 11 or 10 pages and record some information.

Day 27	Read ch. 13 or 10 pages and record some information.

Day 30	Write your front flap. (title, author, illustration, your name)
Day 31	Write your 2-paragraph summary.
Day 32	Have a parent edit and proofread your paragraphs.
Day 33	Choose 1 element from #5 to complete.
Day 34	Choose a 2 <sup>nd</sup> element from #5 to complete.
Day 35	Choose a 3 <sup>rd</sup> element from #5 to complete.
Day 36	Choose an additional element from #5 for extra credit.
Day 37	Edit and proofread what you have already completed.
Day 38	Choose an element from #6 to complete.
Day 39	Edit and proofread everything again.
Day 40	Check your conventions. (spelling, grammar, punctuation)
Day 41	Complete the check off and be ready to turn it in tomorrow!
